



**Remember That Night, David Gilmour Live At the Royal Albert Hall (EMI Records)**

THIS DVD is a must for all fans of top-notch guitar

playing. David Gilmour, the lead guitarist and vocalist of Pink Floyd, conjured up a magical gig at London's Royal Albert Hall – with help from David Bowie, Robert Wyatt, David Crosby and

Graham Nash.

Gilmour played songs from his platinum solo album *On An Island*, which he rates as the best work he has done for 30 years, plus Pink Floyd classics such as *High Hopes*, *Shine On You Crazy Diamond*, *Comfortably Numb* and the 20-minute tour de force *Echoes*.

The DVD extras include a fascinating 46-minute road movie filmed during last year's *On An Island* tour which gives fans a "seat on the tour bus".

This shows a rare glimpse of

Gilmour the man and records how the band endured the highs and lows of life on tour, including flash floods, a collapsing stage and a Russian wine-glass player whose busking on the street so impressed Gilmour that he invited him on stage to perform with the band.
